**2017 Student Selection Criteria**

Boise State University has a 4-year Bachelor of Science degree program in Diagnostic Radiology with a competitive application process. The student capacity per year is 24 individuals

**Initial Criteria:**

- A. Completion of the 30 credits of required prerequisite courses (or equivalent) by the end of the spring semester of the application year. (Students must be registered for these courses at the time of application)
- B. A minimum of 2.60 GPA for the 27 credits of the required prerequisite courses. (DLV and DLL electives must be completed, but not included in GPA compilation) Grades are to be based on at least 13 credits of prerequisite courses. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50.
- C. Completion of a program application by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday in February of the application year, to include a current transcript, letter of intent, and three references.

For the 2017 application process, 71 completed applications were received by the deadline. Three incomplete/ineligible applications were dismissed. Six (6) of the applicants had previously applied to the program (reapplicant). There were 9 (12.7%) male and 62 (87.3%) female applicants.

**Secondary Criteria:**

The applicants were selected for an interview based on prerequisite GPA, letter of application analysis and reference analysis. The top 51 individuals were invited for an interview. 8 (15.7%) males and 43 (84.3%) females were interviewed.
